13. What are the instructor's teaching strengths?

- He's responsive to student's concerns, presents course material and shows how it is used in the real world. He's enthusiastic and realistic about course expectations. He is the best teacher I remember having at UCI.
- He certainly understands what he teaches and explains very well.
- He is able to explain the material in a simple manner.
- He is very approachable and always willing to help. He accepts criticism and always ask us how difficult a quiz was, or how the class is after class. He is very flexible and really shows that he cares for his students.
- He is very patient with and understanding of the students. He is clearly eager for his students to learn and succeed in and beyond this course. He would take the time to show applications to the material in this course using videos, which made the course more interesting. Some questions on his quizzes and exams were tricky, but fair. His kindness made students feel comfortable in asking questions anytime during lecture.
- He knows the material very well and presents it in a highly accessible manner.
- interesting teaching style, clear explanation, teach patiently.
- Simple examples in the lecture while hard questions in exams. He nearly talks about aero in every lecture, which is totally not associated with the class. In the answer key that is provided in EEE, mistakes always appear.

The answers that were posted by the TA's had far too many errors in the calculations to be trusted. I think that for future classes the instructor should do the homework problems himself (preferably by hand because doing math on a computer is difficult to read and follow) and post those at the same time the problems are posted. This way we can check our work as we are going.
